



April 2013 Update

A meeting of the Sauganash Community Association was held on April 30, 2013 at the North Shore Community Bank.

The Snowplowing and Mosquito Abatement Committee reported that they are checking on mosquito abatement. The first spraying should take place the week before the Fourth of July unless the mosquito problem is severe and then it will be done sooner. There is no spraying when it is raining.

The Fourth of July Committee is scheduled to meet on May 3rd to discuss the event. Permits have been filled out and are ready to submit.

The O'Hare Noise Committee chairman announced the intent of the Mayor of Park Ridge to ask that the original environmental impact statement be redone regarding the O'Hare runway issue. He is asking the community associations for their support in the form of a letter. The motions to send a letter in support of the initiative was carried.

The Forest Preserve District Committee Chair gave a report on the City's plan to control the emerald ash borer. The group then agreed to have the Save the Ash Tree Coalition give a presentation at the open meeting in May. The meeting will also include presentations by Andy Ginocchio, the O'Hare Noise Committee Chair, Alderman Laurino, the Sauganash Mural Project., the SCA Website Committee and someone from the 17th Police District.

It was reported that the Holiday Party will take place the first Friday in December at Monastero's Ristorante.

The Website Committee now have a contract, and they are moving along. but the site needs revisions and formatting.

It was reported that the group responsible for the Sauganash Mural Project has completed their donor tile recognition program. They are grateful for the community support. The project will be completed on schedule.

President Renee Bennett presented an applicant for the SCA Board for the upcoming slate. After discussion the group voted to accept the candidate. A motion was made to approve the entire slate of Board Members and Officers to be presented at the open meeting in May for community approval. If approved they will serve the Board as of June 1st, 2013.
