



Meeting Minutes
May 20, 2014

An open meeting was held on May 20th at Sauganash School. Approximately 50 residents attended. There will be mosquito spraying on or about July 1st. Repair work will be done on the Sauganash Murals during the summer. The Department of Water Management and Alderman Laurino's office are working together to fix a standing water issue on both sides of Peterson at the murals. The sewers are higher than the street and therefore water is not able to drain. The Mural Committee is making plans to improve the area just east of the mural on the north side into a "micro park". The property owner owner to the east (Sauganash Glen) has expressed a willingness to participate in the improvement.

To date the SCA has 669 paid households. Sauganash has approximately 1400 households. The SCA encourages all residents to support the work of the SCA. The snowplowing, mosquito spraying, the 4th of July celebration and Holiday Party are funded directly from the paid dues of residents.
